A brief description of the college was presented by the chairman to all the members:

Vardhaman College of Engineering was established in 1999 with 3 U.G Programs and at present has 6 U.G. and 5 P.G. programs running successfully with student's intake of 1032 per year. The college is permanently affiliated to JNTUH, approved by AICTE and is accorded autonomous by JNTUH and UGC. The college is accredited by NAAC with CGPA of 3.24 of 4 scale and five of its UG programs are accredited by NBA. VCE is one among the three shortlisted colleges from Telangana State for 'Centre with Potential of Excellence' scheme during XII plan of UGC. It is registered with and recognized by Scientific Industrial Research Organization (SIRO).

VCE is armed with a dedicated team of faculty members as per AICTE norms. The college encourages active research and promotes its faculty members to publish books and papers in reputed journals. They regularly participate in FDP'S, SDP'S, WEBINARS, SEMINARS, and NATIONAL & INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCES. The college is presently hosting a pilot project in collaboration with IUCEE. The college has several MOU's signed with premier institutions.

The college has continuous growth in its intake every year coupled with excellent results. The college ensures 100 % placements for all the students in reputed MNC's. Students are encouraged to actively participate in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities and bring laurels to the institution.

The college has been ranked AAA+ by CAREERS360 and THE WEEK has ranked the institution among the top 100 in the country.

The college has state-of-art laboratories in all the departments with sophisticated equipment and excellent library facilities with good number of books, journals and online resources for reference & to pursue research. It has a sprawling campus with lush green environment and excellent sports arena for cricket, Indoor & outdoor stadia. The college also has medical room facility, ambulance, hostel, auditorium and transportation apart from special facilities for physically challenged students.
