Dr. T. Vijender Reddy, Chairman, Governing Body (GB) cordially welcomed all the members and handed over to Dr. JVR Ravindra, Member Secretary for further proceedings.

At the outset, the Member Secretary thanked all the members for attending the meeting, formally introduced new members and proceeded with the slated agenda.

Section 1: ITEMS FOR CONFIRMATION AND ACTION TAKEN REPORT

24.1.1 CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS GB MEETINGS

The GB confirmed the minutes of 23rd Governing Body (GB) meeting held on 29-06-2021.

24.1.2 TO NOTE THE ACTION TAKEN ON THE DECISIONS / RESOLUTIONS OF THE PREVIOUS MEETINGS

Subject Number 22.2.6: While discussing on the point, Sri. E. S. Chakravarthy suggested to help students who are not eligible for placements. In response Sri. Manish K. Srivastava submitted that

the college is already working to providing special training and upskilling such students, the results will be expected by the next year.

The Member Secretary apprised that, 59 students who were not eligible for placements are now placed in 26 different organizations with a maximum salary package of 14 LPA and with an average 4.58 LPA.

The GB noted the Same.

Subject Number 22.2.7: After detailed discussion about the faculty IEEE memberships, the GB resolved to make the IEEE Membership as mandatory for all the faculty pursuing PhD.

The Member Secretary apprised that Majority of the existing faculty from circuit branches have taken the IEEE memberships. The newly joined faculty will be encouraged to take the IEEE membership.

The GB noted the same.

Subject Number 22.2.8: Overview of various funded projects schemes is presented to the GB. During the discussion, Sri. E. S. Chakravarthy requested to present the problem statement and other details about the AICTE Scheme for Promoting Interests, Creativity, and Ethics among Students (SPICES) whenever the implementation reaches to a certain level as this is the area where most of the colleges are struggling.

Subject Number 22.2.8: Dr. K. Mallikharjuna Babu, enquired about why the proposals from ECE and MBA are not in the VRPS sanctioned list and opined that the very purpose of the VRPS scheme is to involve every department into research and make this VRPS scheme very stronger.

As per the suggestions of the members, proposals from ECE are approved. A revised total amount of Rs. 22,60,481 has been sanctioned under VRPS. Despite sincere efforts in encouraging proposals from MBA, the committee has not received any proposals.

The GB noted the Same.

Subject Number 22.4.1: The Sri. E. S. Chakravarthy advised to think about the establishment of one more college exclusively for Women Engineering and advised to think about associating B.Sc. courses with each engineering branch like CSE, ECE & ME.

The GB's suggestion was forwarded to the Vardhaman Educational Society executive committee. The committee resolved to consider the same in future.

The GB noted the same.

24.2.1 INTRODUCTION OF NEW MEMBERS TO THE GOVERNING BODY

24.2.1.1 Introduction of New Member Prof. P. P. Binu

The Member Secretary introduced **Prof. P. P. Binu**, Professor, Mechanical Engineering, Sree Narayana Gurukulam College of Engineering, Kerala who was nominated as a member of the GB by the UGC as **UGC Nominee** vide No.F.3-1/2021(AC-GB Nominee) dated 02-11-2021.

24.2.1.2 Introduction of New Member Prof. M. Manzoor Hussain

The Member Secretary introduced **Prof. M. Manzoor Hussain**, Registrar & Professor, Mechanical Engineering, JNTUH who was nominated as a member of the GB by the JNTUH as **University Nominee** vide Lr.No.D1/960/2021 dated 27-07-2021.

24.2.1.3 Introduction of New Member Prof. Archana Mantri

The Member Secretary introduced **Prof. Archana Mantri**, Vice-Chancellor, Chitkara University, Punjab, who was nominated as the member of the GB by the Management under **Educationist** category.

24.2.1.4 Introduction of New Member Dr. S. Rajendar

The Member Secretary introduced **Dr. S. Rajendar**, Dean (Academics) and Professor, department of ECE, Vardhaman College of Engineering who was nominated as a member of the GB by the Principal under **Faculty of the College** category.

The GB welcomed the new members.

The Governing Body after inclusion of new members is shown as Annexure - 01.

24.2.2 NATIONAL BOARD OF ACCREDITATION (NBA)

The Member Secretary apprised that, NBA expert committee conducted inspection for the accreditation of B.Tech. - Civil Engineering programme on 31-07-2021 and 01-08-2021. The inspection was conducted in hybrid mode. Two of the expert committee members including the Chairman and one Programme Evaluator conducted the inspection online and one local Programme Evaluator visited the campus in person.

Post inspection, Vide F. No. 11-131-2010-NBA dated 04-10-2021, NBA has accorded accreditation status to B.Tech. Civil Engineering programme under Tier-1 category for a period of 3 years valid from 01-07-2021 to 30-06-2024 (for the Academic Years 2021-2022 to 2023-2024). The department has secured an impressive score of 724 out of 1000 marks.

The GB noted the same.

24.2.3 NATIONAL RANKINGS AND SURVEYS

The college participates in annual rankings and surveys conducted by all the apex bodies. The details of the current rankings of the college are mentioned as under.

24.2.3.1 National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF)

The Member Secretary submitted that, Ministry of Education, Government of India has announced the NIRF 2021 ranking results on 09-09-2021. With the support and efforts of all the stakeholders, Vardhaman secured 141st Rank in Engineering category and stood among the top 151-200 in Overall Category.

The members appreciated the efforts and advised to work meticulously to improve in all the NIRF parameters.

The GB noted the same.

24.2.3.2 AICTE - CII Survey of Industry-Linked Technical Institutes 2021

The Member Secretary apprised that, the college participated and submitted the survey data for AICTE - CII Survey of Industry-Linked Technical Institutes 2021 on 20-10-2021.

Further, it is also submitted that, in 2018 rankings the college secured a position in Platinum category. The rating for the following years is not announced.

The GB noted the same.

24.2.4 AFFILIATIONS AND APPROVALS

The college takes all necessary affiliations and approvals from the concerned apex bodies. The details of the same were presented by the Member Secretary as under.

24.2.4.1 JNTUH Affiliation

JNTUH Affiliation 2021-2022

The Member Secretary submitted that, in response to the online application (A121) submitted to the JNTUH, the university conducted Fact Finding Committee (FFC) inspection of the college on 28-08-2021 and on 27-11-2021, after which, the university sanctioned affiliation as per the proposed intake for the academic year 2021-2022.

The GB noted the same.

NTUH Affiliation Letter for the AY 2021-2022 is shown as Annexure - 04.

JNTUH Permanent Affiliation

The Member Secretary submitted that, as per the permanent affiliation guidelines published by JNTUH vide Lr. No: JNTUH/ Grant of Permanent Affiliation / Information /2020, dated: 18-03-2020, affiliated colleges are required to submit online application for the permanent affiliation. But, till date the online application process is not initiated. Hence, the college is waiting for the same.

The GB noted the same and in response to the Member Secretary's request, the GB approved to apply for Permanent Affiliation when JNTUH gives provision to apply.

NTUH permanent affiliation guidelines are shown as Annexure - 05.

24.2.4.2 AICTE Approval 2021-2022

The Member Secretary apprised that, in response to the online application submitted for the EoA, AICTE conducted online Scrutiny Committee Meeting on 27-06-2021. Against the verification of required documents as per APH 2021, AICTE sanctioned its approval as per the proposed intake for the academic year 2021-2022.

The GB noted the same.

AICTE Approval Letter for the AY 2021-22 is shown as Annexure - 06.

24.2.5 PLACEMENTS 2020-2021

The Member Secretary apprised that, in comparison with the previous years, the college has recorded tremendous improvement in the placements during the academic year 2020-2021 and the same is expected in the academic year 2021-2022. As a result of consistent efforts of the training and placement cell, students have been placed not only in IT sector but also into core companies, healthcare and banking sectors too, among others.

It is apprised that, a total number of 1291 placement offers were secured by the 2020-2021 batch with an average salary package of Rs. 4,90,246 per annum with a maximum salary package of Rs. 22,03,260 per annum.

Sri. E. S Chakravarthy opined that the placements graph will keep rising till 2024-2025 batch owing to the current trend in software industry. In response, the Member Secretary added that placement cell has successfully placed EEE, ME and CE students into the core companies.

The GB noted the same.

Section 3: ITEMS FOR APPROVAL/RATIFICATION

24.3.1 FACULTY SUPPORT AND PROGRESSION

The college extends financial benefits to the faculty through Group Insurance and Vardhaman Tuition Fee Remission Scheme (VTFRS).

24.3.1.1 Insurance

The Member Secretary submitted that, while considering the suggestions made by the NAAC Peer Team during the visit, staff insurance is enhanced from one lakh rupees to two lakh rupees and the name of the spouse is also included in the policy from the financial year 2021-2022.

The GB highly appreciated the college for enhancing the sum insurance and inclusion of spouse name in the policy.

24.3.1.2 Vardhaman Tuition Fee Remission Scheme (VTFRS)

The Member Secretary shared that, in view of extending support to the employees of college, Vardhaman Tuition Fee Remission Scheme (VTFRS) is introduced for children of Vardhaman employees from the Academic Year 2021-2022. The scheme provides 20% concession in the annual tuition fee, for the wards of the regular employees, who take admission in VCE.

Additionally, the college is offering free education to the wards of some of the lower cadre staff members.

The GB ratified the item and resolved to offer the vacant seats as free education.

The VTFRS document is shown as Annexure - 07.

24.3.2 BUDGET

The annual budget for the financial years as forwarded by the finance committee is submitted to the GB during the meeting.

24.3.2.1 Budget Statements for the Financial Year 2020-2021

The Member Secretary submitted the budget statements for the financial year 2020-2021.

The GB ratified the Budget Statements.

24.3.2.2 Proposed Budget for the Financial Year 2021-2022

The Member Secretary submitted the proposed budget for the financial year 2021-2022.

The GB approved the proposed budget.

24.3.3 NATIONAL ASSESSMENT AND ACCREDITATION COUNCIL (NAAC) -- AQAR

The Member Secretary submitted that, as per the NAAC guidelines, every accredited institute shall submit the online Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) to the NAAC. During the 22nd GB meeting held on 09-05-2021, vide item number 22.2.2.1, the GB approved the request of the Member Secretary for the submission of NAAC AQAR 2019-2020. However, at the later stage the NAAC confirmed that the college needs to submit the AQAR for the year 2020-2021 only.

Draft AQAR prepared by the IQAC for the academic year 2020-2021 is placed for the approval of the GB towards the submission to the NAAC.

After detailed discussion, the GB approved the draft AQAR.

With no other points for discussion, the meeting is concluded with a vote of thanks to the chair.

GUIDELINES FOR PERMANENT AFFILIATION

The College / Institute seeking Permanent Affiliation has to submit an online application along with all existing and new academic program(s) by submitting all supporting documents after the payment of requisite fee of Rs. 1.5 lakhs (as approved by the University from time to time) towards application and inspection fee. After scrutiny of application, Permanent Affiliation Committee shall be deputed by the University which visits the College / Institution and examines the following:

- 1. The College / Institute shall have six years of standing.
- 2. The College / Institute shall have Faculty/Infrastructure as per AICTE/JNTUH norms.
- 3. The College / Institute shall run minimum two PG program(s) other than MBA/MCA.
- The Principal shall be selected as per the norms laid down through the State Government G.O's /other statutory bodies from time to time.
- The College / Institute shall have all the Faculty members selected as per the norms laid down through the State Government G.O's /other statutory bodies from time to time.
- The College / Institute shall have Faculty & Students Ratio as per AICTE norms in vogue.
- 7. Permanent Affiliation will be granted for all courses in the College / Institute, but not for specific courses. However, 60% of the courses offered by the College / Institute shall be accredited by NBA or the College / Institute shall be accredited by NAAC with "A" grade for grant of Permanent Affiliation.
- The University will inspect the College / Institute and all the Courses offered every
 Academic Year along with other Affiliated Colleges / Institutes whether or not the
 College / Institute has been granted Autonomy or Permanent Affiliation before the
 counseling process for TSEAMCET / TSICET / TSECET / TSPGECET begins.
- There shall not be any outstanding dues with regard to Affiliation & Common Service fee.
- 10. The validity of Permanent Affiliation is 3 years and the College / Institute shall apply for renewal of Permanent Affiliation status after competition of 3 years by paying the requisite fee.

- The employees who have completed at least one year of service in Vardhaman College of Engineering are entitled to avail this scheme. This scheme is only applicable for regular employees of the college and not applicable for the probationary / part time / contractual / visiting / guest / ad-hoc / honorary employees.
- This scheme can be availed for maximum of two biological children of an employee.
- The scheme will be discontinued if the employee leaves the college during the course of study
 of the children. Tuition fee remission availed for the subjected Academic Year also need to be
 paid by the employee in such cases.
