Dr. T. Vijender Reddy, Chairman, Governing Body (GB) cordially welcomed all the members and handed over to Dr. JVR Ravindra, Member Secretary for further proceedings.

At the outset, the Member Secretary thanked all the members for attending the meeting in short notice and proceeded with the slated agenda.

Section 1: ITEMS FOR CONFIRMATION AND ACTION TAKEN REPORT

23.1.1 CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS GB MEETINGS

The GB confirmed the minutes of 22nd Governing Body (GB) meeting held on 09-05-2021.

23.1.2 TO NOTE THE ACTION TAKEN ON THE DECISIONS / RESOLUTIONS OF THE PREVIOUS MEETINGS

This item was proposed to be taken-up in the next GB meeting.

Section 2: ITEMS FOR INFORMATION

23.2.1 ACTION PLAN FOR THE CONDUCTION OF EXAMINATIONS AND CLASSWORK POST COVID-19 SECOND LOCKDOWN

The Member Secretary apprised that, Government of Telangana has announced unlockdown from 20-06-2021 and permitted all educational institutions to reopen from 01-07-2021. However, the final year Semester End Examinations (SEE) were conducted between 21-06-2021 & 25-06-2021 in offline mode. For the remaining students' laboratory internal and external examinations are planned from 01-07-2021 and the SEE will be planned accordingly.

Further, in response to the GB members query, it is apprised that Graduation Day will be conducted offline, subjected to COVID-19 situation during the last week of July 2021.

The GB and noted the same and agreed to conduct the examinations & academics in offline mode.

23.2.2 NATIONAL BOARD OF ACCREDITATION (NBA)

The Member Secretary apprised that, NBA has extended the validity of accreditation of the courses B.Tech. CSE, IT, ECE, EEE & ME for one more year against the compliance report submitted by the college. It is informed that, NBA has accorded the extension without conducting inspection due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

The Member Secretary also informed that, the college has submitted new dated (from 30-07-2021 to 01-08-2021) for the peer team visit towards the accreditation of B.Tech. Civil Engineering.

Further, Member Secretary informed that, the college is planning to submit SAR for the 2nd Cycle accreditation under Tier-I category of B.Tech. CSE, IT, ECE, EEE & ME courses by the end of 2021 and requested GB for approval.

The GB noted the same approved the request.

NBA accreditation extension letter is shown in Annexure-I.

23.2.3 UGC AUTONOMOUS STATUS

23.2.3.1 Extension of UGC Autonomous Status

The Member Secretary apprised that, UGC has extended Autonomous Status to the college for a period of ten (10) Years from 2021-2022 to 2030-2031 including the ex-post-facto approval for the year 2020-2021.

The GB noted the same.

UGC autonomous status extension letter is shown in Annexure-II.

23.2.3.2 Conferment of Extension of UGC Autonomous by JNTUH

The Member Secretary apprised that, in response to the UGC communication regarding extension of the Autonomous Status, JNTUH (affiliating university) has conferred the autonomous status for

a period of ten (10) Years from 2021-2022 to 2030-2031 including the ex-post-facto approval for the year 2020-2021.

The GB noted the same.

JNTUH conferment letter is shown in Annexure-III.

23.1.1 AICTE EOA

The Member Secretary informed that, AICTE has conducted online scrutiny committee meeting for the Increase in Intake, Reduction in Intake, New Courses, Extended EoA, Introduction of NRI seats (for new courses) applied by the college on 27-05-2021. All the required documents were shown to the scrutiny committee and the scrutiny committee has recommended all the applied changes from the academic year 2021-2022.

The GB noted the same and while discussing on the item, the GB resolved to allocate necessary Land/Building/funds for the proposed activities.

23.1.2 PLACEMENTS

The Member Secretary informed that, as discussed in the 22nd GB Meeting, the training and placement cell has recorded highest ever placements in Vardhaman with 1013 offers and the placements are still continuing. It is also informed that, for the academic year 2020-2021 achieved 7 offers with more than 10 LPA, 21 offers with more than 7 LPA, 81 offers with more than 5 LPA and the average salary is 4.96 LPA.

The GB noted the same and appreciated the efforts of the Placement Officer.

Section 3: ITEMS FOR APPROVAL / RATIFICATION

22.3.1 AICTE LEADERSHIP IN TEACHING EXCELLENCE (LITE) PROGRAMME

The Member Secretary informed that, AICTE has launched Leadership In Teaching Excellence (LITE) Programme with an aim to equip affiliated institutions with advanced industry knowledge. This programme is done in partnership with *Pupilfirst.org*, founding partner of the National Educational Alliance for Technology (NEAT) programme of the Ministry of Education and implemented by AICTE.

LITE programme would equip the selected institutions with proven tools and curriculums to achieve NEP 2020 Goals such as Learner Centered Pedagogy, Competency Based Curriculums, Continuous and Adaptive Assessments and Continuous Professional Development of Faculty.

Around 50 Institutions will be selected and the selected institutions shall be upgraded as AICTE's Brand ambassadors of change. Out of the nominated computer science faculty from the applicant institutions, 50 would be nationally recognised by AICTE with skills to apply for global employment opportunities.

With reference to the AICTE's notification, Vardhaman has submitted the online application and nominated five (5) of CSE/IT faculty for the programme. As per the requirement, requested the

JNTUH for the issue of Vice Chancellor's permission letter, subsequently the letter was received and submitted same to the *Pupilfirst.org*.

Further, the Member Secretary apprised that, Vardhaman is shortlisted for the programme and request the approval of the GB to offer the programme, if selected.

The GB appreciated the Member Secretary for applying and resolved to offer the AICTE's LITE programme in the college, if selected.

22.3.2 ADMINISTRATIVE REFORMS/UPDATES

22.3.2.1 Appointment of Dean (Outreach)

The Member Secretary apprised that Dr. Mukul Shrivastava, Professor of ME is appointed as the Dean (Outreach) with effective from 25-06-2021.

In response to the members query about the selection process followed, it is reported that, an internal notification inviting the applications for Dean (Academic) and Dean (Outreach) positions is released on 31-05-2021, and an online interview was conducted on 24-06-2021 for the selection of Dean (Outreach). Prof. Ramesh Loganathan, Professor of Practice, Co-innovations, IITH was invited as one of the panel members and based on the panel recommendations, Dr. Mukul Shrivastava is selected for the position.

Further, it is informed that, interview for the Dean (Academic) position yet to be conducted.

The GB approved the appointment of Dean (Outreach).

22.3.2.2 Appointment of HOD, Civil Engineering

The Member Secretary apprised that, while considering the Dr. G. Mallikarjuna Rao's contributions to the department, his term as HOD, CE is extended till 18-06-2022.

The GB approved the extension of Dr. G. Mallikarjuna Rao's term.

22.3.3 FACULTY API

The Member Secretary presented the faculty API draft format for the academic year 2020-2021 and requested the GB for the approval and initiation of increments process.

After details discussions and deliberations, the GB approved the API form and authorised Principal to give certain exemptions in view of COVID-19 pandemic for the year 2020-2021 only.

Draft API format is shown in Annexure-V.

22.3.4 FACULTY RECRUITMENTS

The Member Secretary apprised that, in order to comply with the faculty requirements as per the apex bodies for the next academic year i.e., 2021-2022, faculty recruitment notification was given and the recruitment process was initiated.

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The GB approved the faculty recruitment process and directed member secretary to complete the university ratification process and submit the details in the next GB meeting.

Faculty recruitment notifications are shown in Annexure-VI.

With no other points for discussion, the meeting is concluded with vote of thanks to the chair.
